How does it work?

1. Schedule an appointment.

Call **315-234-2299** to schedule a time that's convenient for **YOU**. Servicing Onondaga, Oswego, Madison, Cortland and Cayuga counties.

2. Installation.

Once you have a time scheduled, our dedicated volunteers and staff will come to your home with smoke alarms and batteries. They will test your current smoke alarms and install new ones if needed.

3. Education.

During installation volunteers and staff will help your family develop a fire escape plan and establish yearly fire drills.

In 2014 the campaign...

Saved 7 lives, installed 31,300 smoke alarms and prepared 19,500 households.
